Petitioner seeks regular under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.389 dated 11.9.2018, registered under Sections 379-B, 201 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station City Barnala (Punjab).

Heard.

Allegations against the petitioner are of snatching of purse containing money and valuables for which petitioner has been booked. Petitioner is in custody since 13.9.2018. Little less than three months are going to elapse. Challan in this case has been presented. Disposal of challan will take time. State does not allege that any other case is pending or registered against the petitioner.

It being so, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned

trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i)The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer,
- (ii)The petitioner will surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any and shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court,
- (iii)He will appear before trial Court on each and every date of hearing, in case of his absent, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail, in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.
