ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0097 dated 16.05.2018 registered under Sections 306 IPC at Police Station Mataur, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 19.05.2018 and all the family members have been examined at the trial. Counsel states that the marriage was over 8 years old and the dispute between the couple related to finances and the couple did not have any child and the death is by hanging when the husband was not at home. Counsel further states that he has got a copy of the complaint dated 29.08.2016 which refers to the fact that the wife was being deprived of funds and was not allowed to work and she herself jumped from the flat when the husband left the home and it is then that she got a fracture and it was not a case where the husband had inflicted any injury.

The main witnesses have been examined.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
