Petitioner seeks regular under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.165 dated 5.6.2014, registered under Sections 379, 411, 420, 467, 468, 471, 473, 120B IPC at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh.

Heard.

Petitioner was arrested on 12.10.2018 and is in custody since then. His co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 19.11.2018 passed in CRM-M-49656-2018. All the offences are triable by the Magistrate. The State does not allege that any other case is pending or registered against the petitioner. Disposal of challan will take time. Therefore, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of

learned trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i)The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer,
- (ii)The petitioner will surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any and shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- (iii)He will appear before trial Court on each and every date of hearing, in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.
