Petitioner Gurnam Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.214 dated 14.12.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala, under Sections 306 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that first of all in the FIR, it is only mentioned that some allegations have been levelled of conspiracy hatched by some person with a lady to falsely implicate the husband of the complainant, who later on, committed suicide. Nothing has been mentioned in the FIR what type of allegations have been levelled. I have also gone through the suicide note in which the deceased is not naming that he is

committing suicide due to present petitioner-Gurnam Singh.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
