The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.131 dated 29.09.2018 under Sections 458, 307, 324, 148 & 149 IPC, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

Heard.

It is alleged that the petitioner Jagdeep Singh @ Jagga, Gosa Singh and Jasdeep Singh alias Nikka armed with sword along with 5-6 unknown persons, entered the house of the complainant. The Present petitioner gave injury with sword on left arm and Jasdeep Singh @ Nikka gave injuries on the left arm to the complainant-Sanjay Kumar. Then Gosa also gave sword blow on the right hand and Gunni gave blunt blow of sword on right thigh of the complainant. Injury No.1 attributed to the petitioner was

found to be grievous in nature.

In the circumstances, I am of the view that there is no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
