The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for seeking direction to respondent Nos.5 to 7 to not to harass or interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners and further to direct respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hand of private respondents.

Reply on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed in the Court and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that the statements of the private respondents have been recorded and according to statements they have no objection to the alleged marriage entered into between the petitioners. The photocopies of these statements have been handed over to learned counsel representing the petitioners.

In view of the statements, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition as there is no existence of threat.
