Petitioner seeks regular under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.20 dated 1.8.2018, registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Patara, Jalandhar.

Heard.

Custody certificate dated 6.12.2018 filed today in Court is taken on record.

In this case, 1564 capsules were recovered from the vehicle, in which the petitioner was traveling, which is commercial quantity.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in this case, investigating officer is I.O. Further, the case is false and that the conscious possession of the petitioner is not prima-facie proved.

I am of the view that in view of bar of Section 37 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, after going through the

contents of FIR, this Court is unable to hold that the case in hand is false.

It being, there is no ground to grant bail.

Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
