Present petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.430 dated 16.11.2018 under Section 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Chand Hut, District Palwal.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Jai Kishan as well as learned counsel representing the complainant contended that the petitioner is required for the purpose of investigation and recovery of weapon i.e. pistol is yet to be effected. Moreso, the petitioner is involved in two more criminal cases under the Arms Act.

In view of the above, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the present petition stands dismissed.
