Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there was a love affair between the petitioner and respondent No.4. However, after some time, she left him and married somebody else. Now, the relatives of respondent No.4 are threatening the petitioner and thus, he fears for his life and liberty. Despite, representation dated 11.11.2018 (Annexure P1), no action is being taken by the police.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 and 5, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P1) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
