RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.' only) for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent No.3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and for bringing the case to its logical conclusion after taking legal action against the accused respondents No.7 to 10, who are roaming freely causing apparent threats to life of the petitioner and their family members and directing respondents No.4 to 6 not to harass the petitioner.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he will be satisfied if direction will be issued to the respondents to consider his representation (Annexure P-1) in time bound manner.

Petition is disposed of with direction to the State to consider and dispose of representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order within a period of 60 days and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of copy of this order along with representation in his office. In the meanwhile, SSP, Amritsar (Rural) is directed to ensure protection of life, limb and liberty of the petitioner as

well as his family members at the hands of the private respondents and in case the petitioner is required in any criminal complaint/case against him, 07 days prior notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. shall be served upon him to enable him to have legal recourse.
