In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for the following relief:

“Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Seeking direction to the respondent No.1 to 3 for handing over the investigation of the case FIR No.419 dated 29.06.2015 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 306 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Samlkha, District Panipat to some senior police officer not below the rank of IPS officer or to some other independent investigating agency.

It is further prayed that the official respondents be directed to take appropriate action against the respondents No.4 to 9 who despite having been specifically named in the above-stated FIR are roaming freely and despite having been properly represented, the local police is not taking any effective measure despite threat to life of the petitioner.”

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Vinod Kumar submitted that except Kulbir and Sanju, rest of the persons have been arrested. Challan has been filed in respect of Satish son of Ram Kuwar
3. Official respondents are hereby directed to expedite the matter insofar as arresting the remaining accused persons.

Having regard to the later development, it is evident that

petitioner's grievance in the present petition has been substantially complied.

5. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of. 2nd respondent-Superintendent of Police, Panipat is hereby directed to file status report and communicate to this Court after three months.
