Through this petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 220 dated 13.10.2014 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420, 409, 465, 467, 468, 471, 167 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel, by filing reply submits that during investigation, the petitioners were found innocent. Therefore, in the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., they have been placed in Column No.2. The police has also apprised the trial Court under Section 173 (8) Cr.P.C. about the innocence of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
