The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 98 dated 22.06.2018 registered under Sections 379-B, 427, 506 IPC, at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 11.07.2018. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as examination of PWs has not yet commenced. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and even in this case, in the facts and circumstances thereof, offence under Section 379-B IPC is not made out.

The factual submissions aforementioned are not disputed by the learned State counsel. He however, submits that the petitioner has snatched money from the complainant and thus, it is incorrect to say that Section 379-B IPC is not attracted.

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Without commenting upon the merits of this case, keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. It would be just an appropriate to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned, at Yamuna Nagar.
