The petitioner was granted interim bail till the receipt of report of the chemical examiner. The report was received but the petitioner did not appear and, therefore, vide order dated 13.12.2017, non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued against her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner wants to surrender and seek regular bail.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 11.12.2018 and to move an application for grant of regular bail. In case such an application is filed, the same shall be decided in accordance with law expeditiously and in any case not later than 10 days from the date of filing of the application.
