In the present petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., grievance of the petitioner is that inquiry is not being conducted in a fair manner by respondent No.3 only.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that for that purpose, petitioner has already made a representation dated 12.02.2017 (Annexure P3) to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but that has not been acted upon.
