KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 30.11.2018. The true relevant extract copy of marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure-P-3. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file Annexure-P-4 (Colly.). The true typed relevant extract copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate, issued by Punjab School Education Board, alongwith true typed relevant extract copy of Aadhar Card, showing the date of birth and year of birth of petitioner No. 1 and true typed extract copy of Indian Union Driving Licenec, Punjab State, and true typed relevant extract copy of Aadhar Card, showing date of birth and year of birth of petitioner No. 2, have been placed on file as Annexure-P-1 (Colly.) and Annexure-P-2 (Colly.) respectively.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 30.11.2018 before the police authorities for protecting their life and

liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents,
true typed copy of which is placed on file as Annexure-P-5.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with
a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar-respondent No. 2, to
consider the application of the petitioners dated 30.11.2018 (Annexure-P-5)
and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and
if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps
be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order
shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the
parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
