The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.244 dated 02.10.2015, registered under Sections 384, 506, 294 IPC and Section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946, at Police Station Kapurthala City, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the ground that the matter has since been compromised between the parties.

Vide order dated 18.09.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned CJM, Kapurthala, has been received to the effect that the statements of the petitioner-accused-Amarjit Singh Riar and

also of the complainant-Prabhjot Kaur have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter. It has specifically been opined by CJM, Kapurthala that compromise has been effected amicably and is a genuine compromise.

In view of the aforesaid report and in the light of law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in **2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others versus State of Punjab**, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.244 dated 02.10.2015, registered under Sections 384, 506, 294 IPC and Section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946, at Police Station Kapurthala City, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1), and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
