Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.166 dated 19.12.2017 registered under Sections 379-B, 34 of IPC at Police Station City Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the complainant and the eyewitness have not supported the case of the prosecution, rather the complainant-Paramjit Kaur while appearing as PW2, has specifically stated that the accused present in the Court were not the same persons, who had snatched her purse. He has further argued that the co-accused Gursewak Singh has already been acquitted by the trial Court vide judgment dated 03.07.2018. However, in the case in hand, non-bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner. The petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court and since the co-accused has been acquitted,

he may be admitted on bail. There is no other case against the petitioner and he is ready to submit an affidavit before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Noticing the fact that the prosecution has not supported the case and the co-accused has been acquitted by the trial Court, present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within a week from today, he shall be admitted on bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court, however, that would be subject to payment of costs of Rs.15,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund of the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner is found indulged in any other case of similar nature, the relief claimed in the present petition shall deem to have been denied.
