Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.204 dated 28.11.2017 under Sections 323, 325 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 3(2) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (for short, the SC/ST Act) [later on Section 452 IPC and Section 3(2) (va) of the SC/ST Act also added] registered at Police Station Bond Kalan, District Charkhi Dadri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that bare perusal of the aforesaid FIR nowhere even remotely suggests that any words were spoken by the accused which may attract the provisions of SC/ST Act. He further suggests that the said FIR has duly been investigated and the police has found the petitioner innocent. However, the petitioner has been ordered to

be summoned by the trial Court on an application under Section 190(1)(b) read with Section 156(3) Cr.PC moved by the complainant.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ripu Daman, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Having considered the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the contents of the FIR as well as noticing the fact that during investigation of the case, the petitioners was found innocent by the police, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, he shall be admitted on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
