Statement of petitioner No.1 Shruti Sharma which has been recorded by the police has been filed. Same is taken on record.

The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondent No.4 not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioners and further directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to allow/let respondent Nos.4 to 6 or anybody else to interfere with the liberty and life of the petitioners.

In compliance of order dated 04.12.2018, passed by this court, petitioner No.2 Sandeep Singh Kaundi has deposited an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in the shape of FDR in the name of petitioner No.1 Shruti Sharma. Copy of the confirmation of deposit has been filed. Same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter has been

amicably settled and the petitioners apprehend no danger from the hands of private respondents and statement of petitioner No.1 Shruti Sharma in this regard has been recorded.

In view of above, the instant petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

In case, the petitioners apprehend any threat to their life, limb and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 in , then they may approach the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, who will provide the protection to them forthwith. If the situation so demands, the petitioners be also provided facility of Protection Home as per their requirement. However, this order shall not be applicable in case any act /conduct of any of the petitioners pertaining to the application, amounts to an offence.
