Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.89 dated 16.04.2018, registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula, under Section 302 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, for the purpose of attending the marriage of his real younger brother which is to be solemnized on 09.12.2018 and 10.12.2018.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned State counsel submitted that there are about twenty eight FIRs, including three under Section 302 of IPC, registered against the present petitioner. Besides this, learned counsel for the complainant submitted that the present petitioner is head of the gangsters and is required in so many cases.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, coupled with the facts that the petitioner has large number of cases pending against him and his presence is not necessary in the marriage of his younger brother, I do not find any ground to grant interim bail to the present petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
