Heard.

Petitioner has been booked for offence under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC in FIR No.378 dated 2.5.2018 registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Trial before the Magistrate is going on. Petitioner was arrested on 14.5.2018. In this case, three witnesses, including the complainant, have already been examined. As such, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i)The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any

inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer,

(ii)The petitioner will surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any and shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.

(iii)He will appear before trial Court on each and every date of hearing, in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.
