Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 not to harass the petitioner by the police, at the behest of private respondents No.5 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar, District Ropar, is directed to look into representation dated 13.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2
