As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of ₹25,000/- (₹ Twenty Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount of compensation of ₹4,08,576/- already awarded by the Commissioner under the Workmen's Compensation Act, vide impugned order dated 21.11.2005, is granted to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed – cheque for ₹25,000/- in the name of appellant – Mahesh son of Sh. Mahipal Yadav with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 27.03.2018, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
