This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 153 dated 17.11.2018 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

Heard.

It comes out that recovery of 100 liters of lahan has been made from the house of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that there is no other case pending against the petitioner and recovery has already been effected.

As such, present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, subject to the condition that petitioner will co-operate in the investigation and appear before the police as and when required.
