JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed seeking to challenge the order dated 02.09.2015 passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar, whereby the revision filed by the respondent has been partly allowed and the order dated 30.07.2015 passed by the learned Sub Judicial Magistrate Bata Bakala Sahib has been modified.

In brief, the petitioners herein filed a petition under Section 125 of Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') along with an application for grant of interim maintenance. The said application for grant of interim maintenance was allowed on 30.07.2015, by which interim maintenance had been allowed to the petitioners from 14.10.2014, by holding that all the three petitioners would be entitled to half of the salary of

the respondent or ₹ 11,000/- per month, whichever amount is greater. The respondent filed a revision against the said order, which was partly allowed. Against the said order, the instant criminal revision has been filed.

This matter has been pending in this court since 2016. A perusal of the interim orders would reflect that there was no stay to the proceedings.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the matter has ripened for final orders before the trial court.

In view of the facts that there is challenge only to the interim maintenance that has been awarded and that the matter has now been fixed before the trial court for final orders, after evidence has been led, this court is not inclined to interfere in the matter at this stage, as evidence in the matter has been led.

Without going into the merits of the case, disposed of accordingly.
