The learned counsel for petitioners states that wife of petitioner No. 4 had eloped with respondent No. 7 alongwith jewellery and cash, regarding which FIR No. 214, dated 13.11.2018, has been registered under Sections 363, 366 IPC, at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal. Now, private respondents are coming to house of petitioner No. 4 and harassing him. Petitioner No. 4 has moved a complaint dated 24.11.2018 (Annexure-P-1) before Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, with a copy of same to Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar, and police authorities of District Kaithal and District Amritsar. Petitioners seek protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

In these circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Kaithal (respondent No. 2) to ensure that petitioners are not being harassed by private respondents and if it happens, taken necessary corrective measures.
