The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, “Cr.P.C”.) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.327 dated 3.4.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) and Section 12 of Passport Act at Police Station DLF, Phase – II, Gurugram.

Heard.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has provided fake identity documents which includes copy of aadhar card and two passports have also been recovered from him having fake address.

The petitioner was arrested on 14.6.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

Nepali son of Ram Dev is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
