Accused Dinesh Kumar, Naveen Kumar and Darshna Devi faced trial by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal, who vide judgment dated 17.3.2011 acquitted all the three accused of the charge framed against them. The said judgment of acquittal was challenged in appeal by State of Haryana but appeal was dismissed by Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal and judgment of acquittal was affirmed. Now State of Haryana has filed the instant criminal revision petition.

I have gone through the judgment passed by the Courts below and I find that there is no illegality or infirmity therewith rather those are well reasoned one based upon the proper appraisal, appreciation of evidence

and correct interpretation of law. I do not see any reason to interfere with such judgments while exercising the revisional jurisdiction. Therefore, the criminal revision petition stands dismissed.
