This petition has been filed for grant of interim regular bail for four months in case FIR No. 414 dated 24.10.2016 registered at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in need of urgent surgery. There are total of four FIRs registered against him and in three cases interim bail has been granted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for a period of four months vide orders dated 01.11.2018 and 30.11.2018 (Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively). Thus, the same relief be granted in the fourth case as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Gulab Singh submits that the petitioner is infact in need of surgery. The police record also indicates that he was admitted in All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi on 07.10.2018 in the department of Surgery for evaluation and management. Thus, the State has no objection in case the interim bail is granted to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is partially allowed. The period of four months granted by the Supreme Court of India would expire on 01.03.2019. Since

this Court is passing the order of interim bail on 06.12.2018, it is directed that the petitioner be released on interim bail till 01.03.2019 subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned. Thereafter he shall be bound to surrender before the latter on 02.03.2019 at 10.00 a.m.
