Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Karnal, filed in Court, according to which the petitioner, in compliance with the order passed by this Court on 08.02.2018, has appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail.

In the light of the above, the order dated 02.01.2017 by which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender, has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has joined the trial proceedings.

Interim bail granted by the trial Court in pursuance to the order dated 08.02.2018 is hereby confirmed and the trial Court shall release the petitioner on regular bail on his moving an application for grant of the same on the next date of hearing before the trial Court.

It would be open to the trial Court to impose strict conditions for the petitioner to continue appearing in the Court.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
