The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 28, dated 08.03.2014, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kot Isah Khan, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an outcome of a sudden fight between the parties and the matter has now been compromised.

Vide order dated 09.02.2018 a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise.

Report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Moga, dated 08.03.2018 has been

received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise is genuine and without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is stated to be an outcome of a sudden fight between the parties and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in “*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*” 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 28, dated 08.03.2014, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kot Isah Khan, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
