Police file perused.

Learned State counsel filed Custody certificate 13.12.2018 today in Court. Same is taken on record.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he along with co-accused were making preparation to commit dacoity No recovery was effected from the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 20.4.2018. Learned State counsel has supplied the information that there are four other cases against him, out of which, he is on bail in two cases. However, he is still in custody in two other cases under Section 379B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also produced on record copies of the orders regarding co-accused, namely, Sukhdeep Singh @

Vicky, passed in CRM-M-35331-2018 on 2.11.2018 and order passed in CRM-M-50069-2017 on 21.11.2018 Harpreet Singh alias Nagi, vide which they were granted bail by this Court.

Therefore, on the ground of parity and also considering the detention of the petitioner, petitioner is also liable to be granted bail. As such, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. One lakh with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i)The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer,
- (ii)The petitioner will surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any and shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- (iii)He will appear before trial Court on each and every date of hearing and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.
