This petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 186 dated 20.09.2018, under Sections 420, 406, 342, 365, 384, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City, Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, the very outset, submits that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and complainant/respondent No.2 as well as respondent No.3 and they have appeared through their counsel.

Respondent No.2 and 3 were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording the statement and both of them have appeared alongwith their counsel and have stated that they have compromised the case only qua the petitioner Amandeep Kaur @ Aman Madam @ Amritpal Kaur and they have no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of regular bail.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate, as per which, petitioner is in custody for the last two months and seven days and is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqua Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
