Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.210 dated 09.10.2018, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural, under Section 409 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 13-1 (A) and 13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the basis of a letter sent by BDPO, Jandiala Guru. As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner, who is an Ex-

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Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat, Geri has misappropriated rent of the shops of Gram Panchayat etc. As per the allegations, he has embezzled the amount of ₹1,50,000/- approximately and the record also.

The petitioner has been in custody since 27.10.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
