Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

The petitioners have approached this Court for the aforesaid protection on the ground that they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of private respondents, who are residents of Kanpur (U.P.). Further, the documents attached with the petition i.e. the copies of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) show that even the petitioners are not residing within the territorial jurisdiction of this Court, rather, they also belong to District Kanpur (U.P.).

Though in the Memo of Parties, the petitioners have shown their present residential address as House No.94-A, Gulumajra, Dera Bassi, District

SAS Nagar, Mohali, but in support of that address, the petitioners have not placed on record any document or evidence, namely, Aadhar Card, driving licence, ration card, voter list etc. showing that they are residing within the territorial jurisdiction of this Court. Thus, in the absence of any such document or evidence, this Court finds that the present petition is liable to be dismissed on account of territorial jurisdiction.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
