Petitioner-Gurwinder Singh @ Goldy has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0010 dated 21.02.2017, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala, under Sections 302, 324, 323, 148, 149, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner was found innocent during the investigation and his name was kept in column No.2. He has been summoned by the trial Court on the basis of evidence produced before it under Section 319 Cr.P.C. No injury has been attributed to him as per the version of the FIR.

The petitioner has been in custody since 20.07.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
