This is a petition that has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.497 dated 19.08.2018, under Sections 363, 366-A of IPC at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

It is contended that allegations as set out in the FIR are patently false and fabricated while submitting that in the statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C before the SDJM Safidon, the prosecutrix has not levelled any allegations. In her statement, she stated that she left the house in the company of the petitioner of her own will.

Learned State counsel opposes the bail application. However, it is not disputed that the entire matter stands investigated and challan has been filed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his

furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty
Magistrate, concerned.
