Petitioner has filed the present revision petition against the order dated 09.09.2015 passed by learned Special Court-cum-Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib whereby the application filed by the prosecution to discharge the petitioner from the custody was declined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that pursuant to FIR No.69 dated 19.07.2015 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, Police Station Kotbhai, District Muktsar, police has prepared a report as provided under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and in the said report, petitioner has been found innocent and placed in column No.2.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Baldev Singh, has not disputed the very fact and states that the I.O. has submitted the report dated 19.02.2018 whereby the petitioner-Amanjot Singh has been found innocent.

In view of the status, so apprised by learned State counsel which is based on the instructions of HC Baldev Singh, this Court finds that present petition no more survives and is rendered infructuous.
