Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar submits that petitioners, namely, Dilbag Rai and Balbir Kaur have since joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and does not oppose the grant of bail together with the contentions of Mr. Sarju Puri, learned counsel for the petitioners that the complainant has settled the matter as per settlement/agreement dated 17.12.2018, which has been received by this Court in original from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim order dated 11.12.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the

conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
