Pursuant to the orders dated 15.2.2018 and 16.3.2018, another affidavit of the Superintendent, Central Jail, Jalandhar, has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, a copy of which has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accompanying the said affidavit is a communication from the Medical Officer of the said jail to the Superintendent, stating therein as follows:-

“The patient at the time of examination was asymptomatic and did not have any abnormality on examination. He has been

advised to continue antiretroviral therapy from ART.

At present Sukhbir Singh s/o Gurmeet Singh is in stable health condition. He is walking on his legs and he is doing daily activities properly by himself. At present he is in stable condition and he is scheduled for further referral to higher institute for follow up and management of his health condition.”

That being so, the petitioner not requiring any specific medical attention outside jail, I see no reason to entertain these petitions, which are dismissed at this stage.
