This order shall dispose of above two petitions as the same have arisen out of the common occurrence and have been filed for quashing of FIR No.64 dated 14.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 34 and 326 IPC (added later on) and DDR No.25 dated 15.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 326 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Chabbelwal, District Hoshiarpur

2. Pursuant to the order dated 09.03.2017, the parties have recorded their statement. In this regard, report of the J.M.I.C, Hoshiarpur dated

18.04.2017, has been received vide letter dated 19.04.2017 of the District and Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur. According to the said report, the compromise is genuine and has been reached between the parties without any threat or coercion and undue influence.

In view of the above, the petitions are allowed and FIR No.64, dated 14.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 34 and 326 IPC (added later on) and DDR No.25 dated 15.06.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 326 IPC (added later on)registered at Police Station Chabbelwal, District Hoshiarpur alongwith all consequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed.
