The petitioner seeks issuance of the directions to respondents No.2 and 3 so as to protect his life and liberty at the instance of respondents No.4 & 5 and their accomplices.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner approaches respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala seeking protection of his life and liberty and moves an appropriate application, the same shall be considered by Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala and in case, there is any genuine apprehension of threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, then adequate steps be taken so as to

ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek his remedies in accordance with provisions of Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. pertaining to the allegations that the transfer deed has been got executed by way of fraud.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
