By way of filing present petition under Section 438 of Code of Civil Procedure, the petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.296 dated 09.11.2018 under Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, 1956 registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

It is conceded by learned counsel for the petitioner that the hotel in question where the raid was conducted is being run by petitioner, namely, Deepak Singh but only in the capacity of a tenant. Be that as it may, it is not in dispute that the petitioner controls the affairs of hotel where the illegal activities as alleged in the FIR were being carried.

No ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
