By this common order, this Court proposes to dispose of the above referred two petitions.

These petitions have been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 06.08.2016 (Annexure P-5) regarding framing of charges in FIR No.0020 dated 16.04.2016 by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ambala and order dated 31.01.2017 (Annexure P-6) passed by Additional Session Judge, Ambala whereby the revision petition stands dismissed.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.1-State has been filed in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the matter stood has been compromised between the parties and thereafter a petition for quashing was filed in this Court i.e. CRM-M-19315-2018 in which all proceedings under FIR No.0020 dated 16.04.2016 registered under Sections 406, 498 and 506 of Indian Penal Code were quashed.

In view of the fact that the very FIR stands quashed, all proceedings thereunder on the basis of quashing of the FIR accused all stand acquitted.

In view of the above, no further orders are recalled for.

Both the aforesaid petitions stand disposed as having been rendered infructuous.
