The petitioner Subhash Chand seeks regular bail in case FIR No.279 dated 07.06.2017, registered at Police Station Shahbad, District Kurukshetra, under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been involved in the FIR, only on the basis of statement of the co-accused and that no recovery has been effected from him. There is no incriminating evidence on record against the petitioner till date.

3. Learned State counsel has not been able to deny the above averment. He further submits that the challan has been presented and charges have yet not been framed.

4. Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner Subhash Chand is ordered to be

released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Judge, Special Court, Kurukshetra.
