Petitioner-Kaalu @ Ravinder Singh seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.1341, dated 16.11.2018, registered at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325 and 506 IPC.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Gurpreet Kaur wherein it has been alleged that on the day of occurrence when she along with her husband Gurdeep Singh and her brother-in-law Gurdeep Singh and nephew Manjot Singh had gone to attend marriage of Banty son of Amarjeet Singh, then they were attacked by petitioner and others. Petitioner Kaalu @ Ravinder Singh is alleged to have given a 'stick' blow on the head of the

complainant; Meet is stated to have given a blow with 'stick' on the right arm of the complainant; Anmol is alleged to have inflicted a blow with 'stick' on the left arm of Manjot Singh and Amarjeet Singh is stated to have inflicted a blow with 'stick' on the head of Gurdeep Singh. Sahib is also stated to have given a 'stick' blow on the left eye of Gurdeep Singh.

The injury attributed to Anmol, who is stated to have been caused on the left arm of Manjot Singh was found to be 'grievous injury'.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and also the learned State counsel and bearing in mind the fact that the petitioner is attributed a single blow with 'stick' on the head of the complainant which had been found to be a simple injury, in my opinion, it is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. The petition, as such is accepted. In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
