The petitioner is working as a teacher in Doaba Institute of Engineering and Technology, Kharar. She allegedly join the institute run by respondent No.4 for obtaining a P.hd degree. Money was allegedly paid in full and the course has been completed. However, the degree is not being given to the petitioner and she feels that she has been defrauded. A detailed representation dated 26.4.2018 (Annexure P8) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.
