The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 135 dated 31.10.2018 under Sections 323, 427, 452, 376, 511, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and the allegations as set out in the FIR are fabricated and are mainly against the co-accused.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer and the complainant, oppose the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner by contending that the allegations

as set out against the petitioner under the above said offences are serious in nature and he deserves to be punished for the above-said offences.

There is a specific allegation that has been raised that the petitioner entered the house of the complainant and tried to commit rape upon her at her house along with the co-accused who gave threat to the complainant to kill her and also caused damages to the house.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that specific allegations has been raised against the petitioner herein regarding an offence under Section 376 IPC and that the matter is still under investigation, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the instant petition and do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for benefit of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
