By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.23 dated 20.2.2016 registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana in respect of offences under Sections 148, 149 and 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 although the petitioner had already been granted bail in the same very FIR in respect of offences under Sections 302, 307 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and also the learned State counsel.

A perusal of order dated 21.11.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-16097-2018 and also in CRM-M-7342-2018 shows that this Court had granted bail to the petitioners for offences under Sections 302, 307 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 in respect of FIR No.23 dated 20.2.2016. However, since in the application other offences had not been mentioned, therefore, no reference was made to the other offences i.e. offences under

Sections 148, 149, 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act.

The learned counsel has submitted that due to inadvertence, the aforesaid offences could not be mentioned in the bail application, when the bail application was filed earlier before this Court.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and also the learned State counsel, the petition is disposed of with a direction that the order dated 21.11.2018 passed in CRM-M-16097-2018 and also in CRM-M-7342-2018 shall ensure offences under Sections 148, 149 and 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act.
